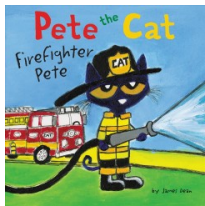

by James Dean

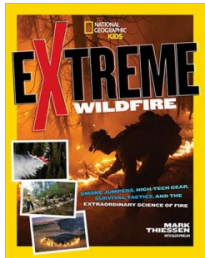

When a fire breaks out in LEGO City, the fire fighters hop in their fire engine and race to put it out

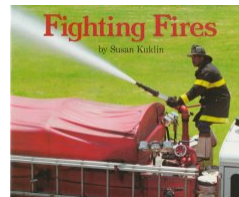


## Extreme wildfire : smoke jumpers, high-tech gear, survival tactics, and the extraordinary science of fire

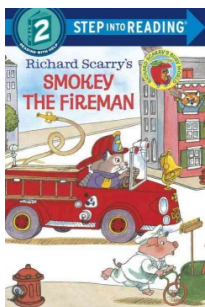

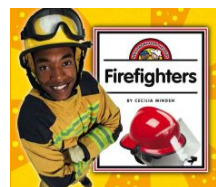
